Tertiary Pathway: Students wishing to apply for university immediately upon leaving school will need to attain an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR).

ATAR eligibility: The calculation of an ATAR is based on a student's:

- best five (5) General subject results; or
- best results in a combination of four (4) General subject results plus one (1) Applied subject result or a Certificate III or higher VET qualification; and
- satisfactorily completed an English subject (i.e. passed English, Literature or Essential English).

Employability Pathway: Students wishing to obtain a job, traineeship or apprenticeship when leaving school, will most likely select subjects from the Applied subjects / Certificate courses column, however they may also choose General subjects as well.
