The Instrumental Music/Strings Fee is supported by the P & C. The fee enables students to play an instrument suited to their ability and assists students to succeed in achieving their instrumental music goals.

The Instrumental Music Program fee encompassing a \$40 participation fee for all students and \$80 instrument loan fee (if applicable), is payable by 13 February 2026.

All students in program - \$40 participation fee provides the following:

- ✓ Regional Instrumental Music Coordinator levy per student
- ✓ purchase of musical literature
- ✓ maintenance of musical library (resource material)
- ✓ photocopying of music and scores for students
- √ various consumables (valve oil, rosin, cork grease, slide oil, reeds, strings and instrument cleaning supplies)
- ✓ maintenance of band/orchestra infrastructure
- ✓ folders

Students hiring a loan instrument - \$80 instrument loan fee provides the following:

- ✓ school instrument
- ✓ maintenance of equipment and instrument repairs
- ✓ purchase of new equipment
- ✓ it is anticipated that students will loan a school instrument for 12 months as beginners, to build skills and gain confidence with their chosen instrument.

If your child discontinues enrolment with the program a pro rata credit will be issued by the term. If your child joins the program during the year a charge for the remaining terms will be due.
