The Instrumental Music/Strings Levy at \$120 is supported by the P & C.  
The levy enables students to play an instrument suited to their ability and assists students to succeed in achieving their instrumental music goals.

The continuity of this program cannot rely on the goodwill of intermittent fundraising to meet all necessary costs to maintain the program therefore, parents are asked to contribute a levy of \$120 per student member for participation in the program in 2024.

**The Instrumental Music Program in 2024 levy is \$120 payable by 2 February 2024**

The \$120 Levy provides for the following:

- ✓ purchase of musical literature (a single concert score can cost \$260)
- ✓ maintenance of musical library (resource material)
- ✓ photocopying of resources for students
- ✓ maintenance of equipment including freight for instrument repairs
- ✓ purchase of new equipment
- ✓ various consumables (valve oil, rosin, cork grease, slide oil, strings and instrument cleaning supplies)
- ✓ purchased teacher-aide time to support the program:
  - photocopying, music librarian and maintenance of copy right restrictions, distribution of student timetables, organisation of certificates and supply of band uniforms.
  - Instrument loans, record keeping and stocktaking, general cleaning and maintenance of instruments, replenish stock (oils, cork, glues, neck straps etc), quotes for repair and replacement of instruments, processing instruments for repair and return into the program and complying with Asset Management procedures.

If your child discontinues enrolment with the program a pro rata credit will be issued by the term. If your child joins the program during the year a charge of \$30 for the remaining terms will be due.
